Vaccination milestone for Aberdeenshire Huge congratulations to all the vaccinators working in Aberdeenshire; as of today, they have vaccinated 100,000 people against 'flu. Across Grampian, the Winter 22/23 programme is now edging close to the 200,000 vaccinated mark. All NHS staff are eligible for a free 'flu vaccination, and if your job brings you into direct contact with patients/clients you can also get a COVID-19 booster. All clinics in Aberdeenshire (Banchory, Stonehaven, Macduff, Fraserburgh, Peterhead, Inverurie, and Huntly), along with Fiona Elcock Vaccination Centre (Elgin), and Aberdeen City Vaccination Centre are open for health & social care staff walk-ins. Getting vaccinated will protect you, your colleagues, and the people we care for.

**Royal Mail strikes** There will be two days of industrial action at Royal Mail next week – 24 & 25 November. Our local mail teams will collect post as usual, but services should be aware there will be a delay in collection and delivery by Royal Mail. <u>More information is available here</u>.
