Boarder Management Team From tomorrow (10 January) a Boarder Management Team will operate in ARI for a three-month test of change. A step in the right direction... We have today launched a new single point of referral to orthopaedics, podiatry, orthotic, and physiotherapy outpatient services, to support adult patients presenting with musculoskeletal foot and ankle conditions.

Implementation of this new multi-professional, system wide, single point of referral has many positive outcomes for both individual patients and the wider system. It is aimed at enabling individuals to build confidence in the management of their own condition, streamlining the referral process, and ultimately enabling people to receive the right care in the right place.

Developing this referral pathway has been a collaborative effort, over several years, involving orthopaedics, podiatry, physiotherapy, and orthotic teams, alongside GP practices and individual service users. To complement the referral process patient information booklets and clinical pathways have been developed, these are available via Grampian Guidance.
